

# Catholic Health Association of BC Bursary for Graduating Students

The board of directors of the *Catholic Health Association of BC* is pleased to announce that it will grant two bursaries in 2012 -- each in the amount of \$250 -- to graduating students who are enrolled in a Catholic secondary school or who are a member of a BC or Yukon parish and enrolled in a public secondary school or who are home-schooled.

Interested students are invited to submit a 500 word essay to the Association by March 9<sup>th</sup>, 2012, that demonstrates an awareness and understanding of the significance of *Spirituality in Health Care*.

Catholic health care is sometimes characterized by what we don't do -- however, what we are seeking from applicants in this exercise is an understanding of that unique, intangible element in the care we give to the spirit and the difference this can make to health and healing.

Applicants are asked to include a return address as well as information about the school he or she attends and the date and place of their graduation ceremony. Emailed submissions must be sent prior to midnight on the 9<sup>th</sup> of March. If submitted by regular mail, they must be date-stamped on or before the 9<sup>th</sup>.

A committee of the CHABC board of directors will evaluate all submissions that are received by the specified due date and announce the recipients of the bursaries before April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2012.



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
